Announcing the Embellished Tiara Challenge, the theme for the challenge is: All About the Sparkle. This is a really fun challenge/contest.

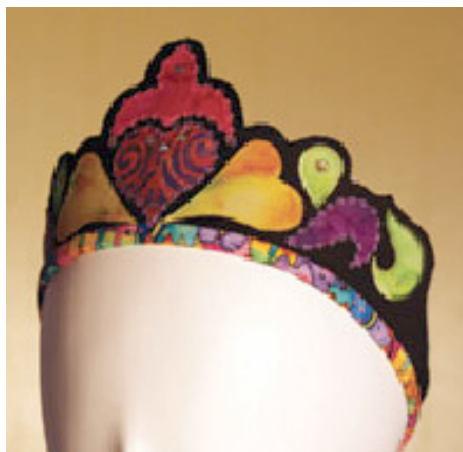
Everyone starts with the same \$16 challenge package. The supplies in the

Due to the relentless hours put in by the Show Committee, the heavy turnout of Patrons, the wonderful work of the volunteers and of course the fabulous vendors our Dallas Quilt Celebration was a huge success. We knew that when we watched the continuous line of Patrons entering the Show, the smiles on everyone's faces, and the compliments that all of us received. We had the success reestablished when we got the total attendee numbers (third highest). But we now have it financially confirmed. We made an incredible profit of \$45,631.56 (our goal was to make a profit of \$20,775). I have been told (from very reliable sources) that this is the highest profit ever.

You may wonder what this money is used for. The profit from the Show funds the Guild's general expenses (which includes monthly speakers and their workshops, grants, community service programs, library books, etc.).

Thank you all for your hard work. I hope many of you will consider being on the 2010 Show Committee or volunteering at the Show.
