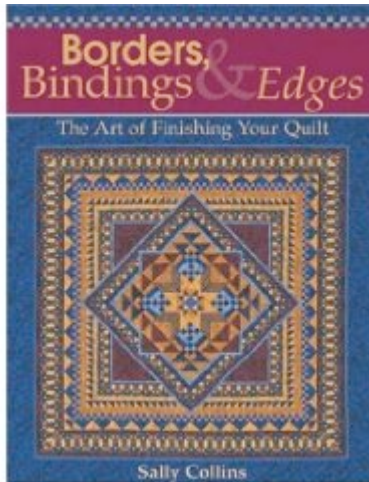
The workshop supply list is attached.

The bank is located near the southwest corner of Central Expressway (US 75 North) and Arapaho in Richardson, Texas. Take the Arapaho exit off Central Expressway/ US 75 N. The bank is on Belle Grove, a short street that is one block south of Arapaho and West of Central Expressway. It is just south of the Richardson City Hall and next to the Richardson Post Office.

The Guild has some extension cords, irons and ironing pads. For classes where an iron is needed you may want to bring your own iron.

Borders, Bindings and Edges

This Lecture/No Sew class will focus on how to design, figure out and fit pieced borders, corner triangles, narrow borders, spacer borders, automatic fit borders, and mitered symmetrical border prints to your quilts. I will define, explain and illustrate each style with lots of quilts, visual aids and mock-up samples. Time permitting, some binding and edge styles will also be covered. Note-taking supplies are all you need. If you are interested in bringing your next quilt to a beautiful conclusion, this is the class for you. Although this class is based on my newest book “**Borders, Bindings and Edges**” it is not required for class. *All Skill Levels Welcome.*
